Please bring a water bottle, come dressed for the weather, and wear shoes that are suitable for uneven terrain (that can get muddy). Binoculars are a great way to enhance this class, but are not required. This class is best suited for ages 13 and up.

Please note this hike is presented by the City of Southlake Parks and Recreation, open to all, and is free. There are a number of slots still open. The hike, as always, will feature birds but is more directed to the ecology of the area and beginning birders.
