# STUDENT ART CONTEST

## Rules:

1. Students in grades K – 1 are eligible to enter the contest as Sprouting Artists, in grades 2 – 3 as Budding Artists, and grades 4 – 5 as Blooming Artists.
2. Entries should be completed by students with minimal parental assistance.
3. **To qualify for judging, the student must follow these rules:**
  - **Entries must be no larger than 18" x 24".**
  - **The 2025 contest theme "Wings of Change" must be written on the front of the entry.**
  - **No computer, AI or other electronically-generated artwork.**
  - **Entries must be flat — no 3D artwork.**
  - **Use crayons, markers, paints, water color, etc.**
  - **Poster board and thin, flat canvases are allowed.**
  - **Artwork on lightweight paper needs to be mounted on a heavier paper such as poster board.**
4. Entries will be judged on originality, design, slogan, artwork and overall effectiveness of the message.
5. Entries will be on display Saturday, October 18 from 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. at Butterfly Flutterby, presented by 121 Community Church. The gallery will be located at the Pewitt Educational Pavilion at Grapevine Botanical Gardens.
6. Winning entries for each grade level will be awarded a first, second, third or honorable mention ribbon. One grand prize winner in each group, Sprouting Artists, Budding Artists and Blooming Artists, will each be awarded a prize. Grand prize, first, second and third prize winning entries will be on display at The Rec and Grapevine Library until mid-November.
7. All artwork will be returned to the student's art teacher. All entries may be used for future publications, exhibits and social media at the discretion of the Grapevine Garden Club and the Grapevine Convention & Visitors Bureau.
